Your artwork must reflect Mornington Island cultures All entries must be accompanied by a signed and completed Entry Form including design story by 5 pm on Friday 30th May 2016. Entry limit of one entry per artist and no late entries will be considered.

Gununamanda Store Uniform Competition

**Terms and Conditions:**

1. The artwork must reflect Mornington Island culture,
2. All participating artists must:
  - Be of Mornington Island descent;
  - All participating Artist must be 15 years and over; participating Artist under 18 years must have a parent/guardians permission to enter into the completion.
3. All entries will be viewed by and judged by a panel of the Gununamanda Board and Store representatives.
4. The artist is to submit only one artwork.
5. The winning artist acknowledges their artwork will be copied and reproduced for the purposes of the Gununamanda Uniforms and promotional material. The winning artist will be required to supply an original copy of their design for reproduction by 5 pm on Friday 30th May 2016.
6. No group entries will be accepted.
7. The artwork dimensions should measure: A3 size or no larger than 60cm X 40cm. Artwork should not be framed or mounted behind glass.
8. All participating artists warrant that they are 15 years and older at the time the Entry Form is submitted; the art work submitted is original work; the artwork submitted has not been the recipient of a major prize before; and that they have not charged or otherwise encumbered the work nor given any assignment inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions. Where a participating artist is under the age of 18, the artist's adult parent/guardian must complete the Entry Form by stating their own name on behalf of the artist.
10. The decision of the judges will be final and absolute. No correspondence about the decision will be entered into.
11. Property rights in all submissions, including the winning artwork, will remain the artists except as provided by these Terms and Conditions.
12. By signing a completed Entry Form, submitting an artwork and accepting the award offer, the winning artist: grants Gununamanda LTD, royalty-free, worldwide, irrevocable, ongoing, non-exclusive licence (including a right of sub-licence to use, reproduce, distribute, adapt, modify the winning artwork in all media of expression now known or later developed for the purpose or any other purpose associated with the Gununamanda Ltd and other Indigenous engagement initiatives, including but not limited to, reproducing and publishing the winning entry of the official 2016 winner and runner ups
  - Consent to any of the following types of acts or omissions by Gununamanda LTD: (a) use of all or part of the art work in accordance with the licence granted above, with or without attribution of authorship to the artist. (b) Supplementing the art work with any other material; and (c) use of the art work in a different context to that originally envisaged;
  - Warrants that there is no cultural or religious reason or any other impediment that prevents the winning artwork from being exhibited, published or reproduced.
13. All entries must be received by 5 pm on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2016.
