

CORONAVIRUS **(COVID-19)** **COMMUNITY NOTICE**

Mornington Island Health Council, in collaboration with the Mornington Shire Council and the Local Disaster Management Group (LDMG), advise that **UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE**, due to Coronavirus, travel into Mornington Island is limited only to those people involved in the provision of **ESSENTIAL SERVICES** in the community. Residents of the community travelling must take precautionary measures prior to travelling.

ADDITIONALLY, the following people **SHOULD NOT TRAVEL** to Mornington Island.

- Any person who has been diagnosed with or suspected to be infected with Coronavirus;
- Any person who is displaying symptoms of the Coronavirus;
- Any person who has travelled overseas or has had close contact with someone who has travelled overseas, in the last 14 days.

THESE RESTRICTIONS APPLY TO BOTH VISITORS AND RESIDENTS OF MORNINGTON ISLAND.

These restrictions have been applied in the interest of the ongoing health and safety of our residents.
