



CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) COMMUNITY NOTICE 2

In addition to current travel restrictions, Mornington Shire Local Disaster Management Group (LDMG), in collaboration with the Mornington Island Health Council, advise that as of Monday the 30th of March 2020 and UNTIL

FURTHER NOTICE, due to Coronavirus, ALL travel to and from

Mornington Island will be restricted to **ESSENTIAL SERVICES** only. Anyone travelling from interstate to Mornington Island between Monday 23rd March and Monday 30th March must go through 14 days quarantine immediately upon arrival.

If anyone wishes to return to Mornington Island, it <u>MUST</u> be before Monday 30th March because after this date restrictions and quarantine WILL apply.

THESE RESTRICTIONS WILL APPLY TO BOTH VISITORS AND RESIDENTS OF MORNINGTON ISLAND AND WILL INCLUDE PLANE AND BOAT TRAVEL.

These restrictions have been applied TO PROTECT the ongoing health and safety of our residents.
