Making of Amending Subordinate Local Law

Mornington Shire Council ("the Council") has, by resolution dated 17 November 2021, made *Amending Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Animal Management) 2021* ("the **Amending Subordinate Local Law**").

Local law that authorises the subordinate law to be made

The Amending Subordinate Local Law is authorised to be made by *Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2016*.

Subordinate Local Law Amended

The Amending Subordinate Local Law amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2016*.

Purpose and General Effect

The purpose and general effect of the Amending Subordinate Local Law is to amend *Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2016* to require the desexing requirements of stallions in certain circumstances, and to insert a map of the designated town area.
